Environmental justice can be defined as, the fair treatment and meaningful involvement of all people regardless of race, color, culture, national origin, income, and educational levels with respect to the development, implementation, and enforcement of protective environmental laws, regulations, and policies. However, when it comes to black, brown and low-income communities this definition falls short.

GALILEO


