### **GALILEO**

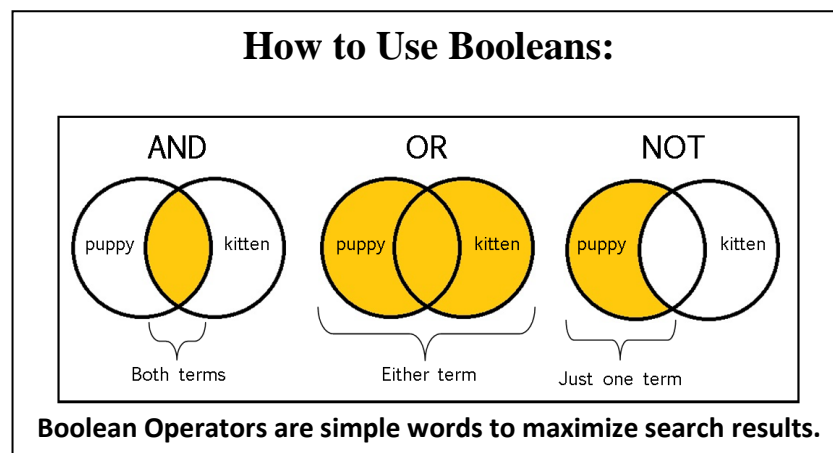
