

Community Ticket Pass FAQ

Please read carefully.

When checked out & taken to the Alliance, the Pass is good for two (2) free admissions tickets for performances on the **Hertz, Coca-Cola Stage, and Goizueta Stage for Youth and Families ONLY.**

You may also inquire about about an additional **50% off for family shows ONLY.**

Tickets for performances are available on a first come, first serve basis. They are non-transferable and cannot be used for other events, classes, or programs.

To receive free admissions, you have two (2) options:

1) Present the Library Pass at the Alliance Box Office in-person to book tickets for a show. This can be any show for which the Alliance is currently offering tickets to see, meaning, you can reserve tickets for performances during the current run of that particular performance. When the Pass is presented at the Box Office for a selected performance, your will receive tickets for that performance. You no longer need the Pass see your show, so you can return it to your lending library.

2) Present the Pass at the Alliance Box Office *on the date and time of the show you wish to see.* If tickets and seats are available for that date and that time, you will receive free tickets and be allowed admittance to the Theatre. It is highly advised you call the Alliance ahead of time or check online to ensure tickets are available for the performance you wish to see.

Parking for Woodruff Arts Center events is conveniently located in The Woodruff Arts Center parking garage located on Arts Center Way. Drop-off and pick up is available on Callaway Plaza via Peachtree Street and on 16th Street. The Woodruff can be easily accessed by public transportation at the Arts Center MARTA station (N5), across Arts Center Way from The Woodruff.

Additional parking options for evenings, weekends, and other peak visiting times are available at the Promenade parking garage, located on 15th Street, and the Boys & Girls Club, located on Peachtree Street across from the Woodruff Arts Center.

For GPS purposes, use 1280 Peachtree Street NE. If parking in the Woodruff Arts Center Parking, you will pull a ticket when you enter and pay when you leave.
